Z. Selin Hur is a Strategic Programs, Principal at CACI International Inc in Arlington, VA. She works with the company's Executive Chairman to provide thought leadership in national security and information technology, and supports the company's strategic growth initiatives. Ms. Hur also contributes to CACI's leadership development and corporate culture programs. In these roles, she prepares numerous articles and speeches on defense, technology, and organizational development. Ms. Hur was part of the crisis management team when CACI was falsely implicated in the Iraq prison abuse scandal.
