Banner Program

Alumni Clubs/ Councils are integral components of the Pitt Alumni Association as they serve as direct channels for alumni to maintain their University involvement across the world. Through the Banner Program, Clubs/ Councils are recognized for their annual service through activities that support the mission of the Pitt Alumni Association.

The Banner Award Program highlights the facets of the synergetic relationship between the Clubs/ Councils and the Pitt Alumni Association. Banner eligible Clubs/ Councils that complete the determined amount of qualifying activities within the fiscal year will earn monetary awards that will be added to their respective scholarship funds. In addition to the requirements listed below, each Club/Council must also provide **by October 6th, 2014:**

- *2014 Fiscal Report*
- *Clubs/ Councils must have completed a minimum of 3 activities to qualify for the \$250 award and a minimum of 6 activities to qualify for the \$500 award*
- *Clubs/ Council are responsible for costs associated with these activities.*

Please mark the qualifying activities that your club / council has completed to be eligible for this year's banner award.

Where possible, please include documentation that confirm completion of each marked activity.

FY'14 QUALIFYING ACTIVITIES

- Host a scholarship fundraising event to support club scholarship fund
- Provide PAA with up-to-date listing of current officers/ leadership team, all of whom are current Pitt Alumni Association life or annual members
- Have 5 club/ council members participate in a student recruitment program (PART)
- Have 5 club/ council members participate in the Pitt Advocates program
- Have 5 club/ council members join the Pitt Alumni Association
- Participate in at least one community service activity

- Host a Freshmen Sendoff event for incoming Pitt students
- Award a scholarship to a local student attending Pitt
- Host a Pitt game watch event
- Provide at least one job shadowing/ internship opportunity for a Pitt student
- Provide the Pitt Alumni Association with pictures from alumni events
- Identify/ nominate a candidate for board membership
- Nominate worthy alum for the alumni awards program
- Host an alumni social gathering (happy hour, brunch, business card swap, etc.)
- Host a post-season game watch event (Big East tourney, NCAA Tournament, bowl game)
- Host a recreational activity for alumni and their family (sports activity, amusement park outing, museum trip, etc.)
- Host a National Networking Day event

NOTE: The above activities are examples of possible activities that can be implemented to achieve Blue or Gold Banner status. The Pitt Alumni Association recognizes that there may be other activities/events sponsored by Clubs/ Councils that would show partnership and support of the Pitt Alumni Association. If submitted with the appropriate documentation, they will be taken into consideration when awarding the banners.
